MINUTES: Dennis Gutwein made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on June 4, 2020. Jonathan Gutwein seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

REQUISITIONS: Kyle McTeigue made a motion to approve requisitions 20110 through 20122 for the corporation. Jeff Tanner seconded the motion and the requisitions were approved.

EMPLOYMENT: Jonathan Gutwein made a motion to approve the following employments as presented:
